Eligibility

In order to be eligible, a student must (i) be enrolled in an accredited college or university, (ii) be majoring in art or art history, and (iii) have completed his or her first year of study with a grade point average of at least 3.0 or greater.

Application Process

Applicants must submit a letter application and provide proof of their eligibility. The letter should describe the applicant's educational and career goals, and any information which shows the applicant is a deserving student. The letter should also identify the names and telephone numbers of two or three references familiar with the applicant's ability and aspirations. Proof of eligibility must come in the form of an official transcript from the college or university which shows that the applicant is enrolled beyond the first year of study with a major in art or art history, and has attained a grade point average of at least 3.0 the prior year of study. (Note: If the institution does not use a GPA grading system a letter indicating the student's good standing from the department chair or advisor may be substituted.)

Applicants should send the required information to the YAA Scholarship Committee, York Art Association, PO Box 74, York, ME 03909.

The application deadline is September 1, 2010. A decision will be made within 60 days thereafter.

Scholarship awards will be paid directly to the college or university and are for tuition only. The scholarship amount will be determined by the YAA Executive and Scholarship Committees, at their discretion.

YAA Trustees, their families or designees who make candidate recommendations are not eligible to participate in this program.
